

Eula ISD Meets Highly Qualified Teacher Requirements

The No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLB) requires each local education agency (LEA) to publicly report progress of the LEA and its campuses toward meeting the highly qualified (HQ) teacher requirements.

The annual targets set up by NCLB are as follows:

2005-2006 Target	100.0 %	100.0%
